Our 10 Priorities

1. Leadership

We acknowledge inclusive and stewardship leadership

2. Role of healthy people

Recognising the importance of happy and healthy people through a 'whole of society' approach

3. Value of the Pacific Common and Collective

Assessing the value and contribution of ecological, social, spiritual and cultural assets to inclusive and sustainable development. Sustainable development principle (Rio)

4. Long term financing / trust funds – support to communities

Promoting long-term financial support for communal green growth sustainable development initiatives

5. Rigor in implementation of key national and regional commitments

Sustaining green economy initiatives at the national and regional levels – regulatory, accountability and incentives.

6. Reform of financial system

Reform of national, regional and global finance systems, including budgetary processes.

7. Education and capacity building

Integration of sustainability into all levels of education

8. Sustainable transport

Prioritize alternatives to fossil fuels, including sustainable shipping approaches for remote islands

9. Food security

Prioritize inclusive and sustainable agriculture and fisheries development

10. Re-Energizing the Pacific

Focus on renewable energy and energy efficiency
